Re: EnCirca's ProForwarding Service

Dear Bret,

We refer to your series of postings on .PRO and Encirca but in particular your post on blog.lertext.com dated March 26, 2005 that states: "Non-credentialed individuals can now register second-level .PRO names en masse through Encirca's new Bulk .PRO Registration form."

In view of your own registration of .PRO domain names with EnCirca and your conversations with me, you are precisely aware of the process for registering second level .PRO domain names and of EnCirca's ProForwarding service, namely that no .PRO names are registered to non-credentialed individuals.

Your statements on your blog that "Non-credentialed individuals can now register second-level .PRO names" on EnCirca is false on its face and you are well aware of this fact. As a member of the California bar, you should know better than to deliberately publish these falsehoods.

I demand that you remove the comments containing these falsehoods and publish an apology. I also demand that you acknowledge you know of no .pro domains that have been registered without professional credentials and you are aware of EnCirca's policy not to register to non-credentialed entities.

I will give you until 5pm PST on Monday, March 28 to respond before we pursue other options to correct the false statements.

This is without prejudice to rights and remedies, all of which are expressly reserved.
